Upon arrival, you will be issued uniform shirts, a water bottle, and necessary safety equipment as needed. Below is a list of suggested items for work.

ear & C	lothing Suggestions:
	Rubber chore boots: for rain and animal chores
	Closed-toe shoes: for field work
	Closed-toes shoes for indoor use: kitchen, office, and housing
	Wool socks
	1 Large water bottle (VYCC does provide a Nalgene)
	Work Pants and/or work shorts (long pants required for certain tasks)
	Day Pack
	Rain Jacket and Pants: slickers tend to be the most durable in the field
	Watch
	Insect Repellent
	Warm Layers
	Sun protection: Such as a hat, sunglasses, sun shirt. VYCC provides some sunscreen but fee
	free to bring your preferred sunscreen
Recommended Housing Items:	
	Bedding for twin sized mattress: pillows and sheets
	Toiletries
	Headlamp / flashlight or battery-operated lights (yurts don't have electricity)
	Laundry Basket/Hamper: there is a shared washer and dryer in the farmhouse
	Towel(s)
